## MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

I, Anthony M. Traversino, Jr., Highway Commissioner of Aurora Township, Kane County, Illinois, did, as provided by statute, fix a time and place when I would examine the portion of Diehl Road proposed to be vacated, legally described as follows,

That part of Marywood Acres Unit 5, a subdivision of part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 11, Toynship 38 North, Range 8 East of the Third Principal Meridian, described as follows: Commencing at the Southeast corner of Lot 127 of said Marywood Acres Unit 5; thence Northerly on a 3°01 degree curve to the left along the Easterly line of said Lot 127 and of Lot 126 of said Marywood Acres Unit 5 to the Northeast corner of said Lot 126; thence Easterly along the North line of said Lot 126 and the Northeast corner of said Lot 126 thence Easterly for 67.8 feet; thence Southerly on a 2°55 degree curve to the right, parallel with said Easterly line of Lots 126 and 127 for 473.15 feet to a point on the Easterly extension of the Southeast corner of said Lot 127; thence Westerly along said Easterly extension for 66 feet to the point of beginning, in the Township of Aurora, Kane County, Illinois;

that I did then and there after due publication hear reasons for and against the vacation of said portion of Diehl Road, and publicly announce my decision/


It is my decision, as so announced, that the proposed vacation of a portion of Dienl Road be to granted.

I find that such vacation is the public and economic interest and that no person residing or owning land within two miles of any portion of Diehl Road proposed to be vacated shall be denied reasonable access by way of a motor vehicle to the land he owns or operates or to community and trade centers after the road is vacated.
