**BACKGROUND:**

WHEREAS, the organizers of this event have filed all appropriate documentation and paid all applicable fees required for the issuance of said permit; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Aurora, Illinois, as follows: that a Music Festival permit be issued to St. Rita of Cascia, 750 W. Old Indian Trail, for August 14th, 2016 from 1:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m.
