**SUBJECT:**

A resolution reappointing Michael Scott Collins to Aurora's Grand Army of the Republic (GAR) Commission.

**BACKGROUND:**

The GAR Commission is a nine (9) member commission tasked with overseeing Aurora's Grand Army of the Republic Museum. Duties include: preserving and maintaining the history of the building, raising money for the future of the GAR and making the premises available to the public.

In July of 2016, the City Council approved an amendment to the Code of Ordinances related to the membership composition of the GAR Commission, allowing for a limited number of non-residents to be members. The change was made to provide more of a regional focus for the museum, making it a destination for downtown Aurora.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended the reappointment be approved.

A Resolution Reappointing Michael Scott Collins to Aurora's Grand Army of the Republic (GAR) Commission.

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has a population of more than 25,000 persons and is, therefore, a home rule unit under subsection (a) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, subject to said Section, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, there are currently vacancies and an expired term on Aurora's Grand Army of the Republic (GAR) Commission; and

WHEREAS, it is the Mayor's desire that said reappointment be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Aurora, Illinois, hereby approve the reappointment of Michael Scott Collins, Montgomery, IL to the Aurora Grand Army of the Republic (GAR) Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of Michael Scott Collins shall expire May 31, 2022, however, in any event, he shall continue to serve until his respective replacement has been approved by the Council.
